TECHNICAL INFORMATION OF TRACK EVENTS

Communiqué no. 5 bis

If riders wearing the same team clothing ride in the same race, they shall bear some item to distinguish between them.

Riders may carry no object on them or on their bicycles that could drop onto the track. They may not carry or use on the track any music player or radio communication system. Road bikes are not allowed on the track including the apron.

Points Race

Men Qualifying: 15km, 6 sprints, best 12 in each heat qualified to final.

Final: 30km, 12 sprints.

Women will go direct to final. Final: 20km, 8 sprints.

In the case of a recognized mishap, the rider shall be entitled to a neutralization of 5 laps.

Neutralized riders are not allowed to return to the track during the last kilometer, but shall nevertheless appear in the final placing depending on the points accumulated prior to the mishap.

Riders shall wear special number panels (beginning from number 1) which will be distributed the day of the race at the commissaire's area inside the track. Numbers will be available at the latest 30 minute prior to the start of the program.

Sprint & 200 meter Time Trial

Riders shall wear both number panels during the 200 meter Time Trial.

MEN: Best 18 qualified to Sprint Tournament which will start from 1/16 Finals.

WOMEN: Best 12 qualified to Sprint Tournament which will start from 1/8 Finals.

Olympic Formulae will be followed.

Race is over 3 laps.

500 meter Time Trial

Each rider shall take the track alone.

Team Pursuit

The team of a rider that has stopped following a mishap shall restart at the end of the qualifying Rounds.

If a team suffers a mishap during its subsequent ride, it shall continue with 3 riders or be disqualified.

Best 8 teams in Qualifying Road go to Round 1.

Team Sprint

The riders of each team shall start either side by side or staggered at an angle of 45° behind the start line. The lateral distance between each rider shall be equal and be between 1.5 and 2 meters.

Best 4 teams qualified for Finals. Team will best time and 2nd best time will race for Gold, the other 2 teams will race for Bronze.

Keirin

Distance is 8 laps.

There are 3 heats of 7 riders in Round 1. Best 2 in each heat will qualify for Round 2. Losers go to repechages (3 heats of 5 riders), 1st and 2nd will qualify to Round 2.
