| Facts found: 1. Wind was 8 knots. before the start, both SIN and MAS were on starboard tack. 2. 5 second before the start, MAS established windward overlap with SIN. They were one and a half boat lenght apart. Singapore was on close-hauled course and MAS sailed below the close-hauled course. 3. After 5 to 6 second, there was a contact between SIN and MAS. 4.
